Tuition and Fee Payment Information

1. Prozdor is a full-year program, and tuition is paid on an annual basis. Prozdor hires teachers and secures classroom space based on the number of students at the beginning of the academic year. Therefore, **your tuition includes a \$500 non-refundable deposit**, which must be paid at the time of enrollment. *If a student is withdrawn for any reason after classes begin, but before September 30, 2010, you are responsible for 50 percent of all tuition and fees; if a student is withdrawn for any reason after September 30, you are responsible for 100 percent of all tuition and fees.*
There will be no exceptions to this policy.

2. No deductions or refunds shall be made in the event of extended absence, dismissal or change in program hours.

3. There will be a \$100 tuition discount for payment *in full* by June 1.

4. There will be a \$75 tuition discount for payment *in full* by August 1.

5. Families paying in two installments must submit either a credit card number to be charged on November 1, 2010, or a second check, dated November 1, 2010. Both checks, including your post-dated second check, must be submitted at the time of enrollment.

6. Prozdor contracts with Tuition Management Systems (TMS) to enable you to spread out your payments over the course of several months. Monthly payments must be completed by March 2011, regardless of the date of your first payment. If you would like to take advantage of this payment plan, there is a \$45 fee per student, payable to TMS.

7. Bus fees are \$295 for round trip and \$150 for one-way.

8. The Hebrew fee is \$75 per student. All students enrolled in Hebrew language classes must pay this fee.

9. We are very much aware that, for many people, these are difficult economic times, and we firmly believe that financial challenges should not preclude anyone from attending Prozdor. However, please also understand that our financial aid budget is more limited than it has been in the past. The key to getting the financial aid you need is to send in your enrollment form and complete financial aid application (with your signed 1040) as early as possible. The deadline for financial aid applications is July 1, 2010. In order to be considered for financial assistance, we need to have a signed copy of your entire 1040, with all schedules attached, along with your enrollment application and \$500 tuition deposit. *Please understand that if we receive your financial aid application after the deadline, there will be fewer resources available.*

10. If you are able, please consider a donation of \$36 to help cover the cost of tuition for families who have been hit hard by the current recession.
